

CTPC Club Championship Process **Effective January, 2007**

CTPC will conduct a season-long competition to determine both a net Club Champion and a gross Club Champion.

Definition of Season

For purposes of determining the CTPC Club Champions, the season will begin with the January event and will end with the November event. Should the club have a December event, scores for that event will have no bearing on determining the Club Champions.

PLGA Tournament of Club Champions

The CTPC gross Club Champion will represent the club in this annual PLGA tournament.

Eligibility

To be eligible for a club championship, the member must participate in and post scores in at least 5 CTPC events.

Net Club Champion

This will be the member with the lowest average net score of his/her best 5 net scores

Gross Club Champion

This will be the member with the lowest average gross score of his/her best 5 gross scores

Tie-Breaking Process

If two or more members tie for a given award, the average net/gross score of their best 6 rounds shall be computed to break the tie. If still tied, then use the average of the best 7 rounds, etc. If, in this tie-breaking, one member does not have sufficient rounds played to proceed to the next level, he/she shall be the loser. If this procedure still does not resolve the tie, then duplicate awards will be given.
